All students will register for AP tests by using the online registration system.

Go to: [www.TotalRegistration.net/AP/371905](http://www.TotalRegistration.net/AP/371905) and complete the online registration form. Select your method of payment and print off two copies of your completed registration. Bring one of those copies, along with your payment, to the College Office. You may also pay online using a Visa, Mastercard or Discover for an additional convenience charge of \$2.00 per test.
